Description

FO100 Putty Pads are an easy to apply fire and sound rated seal supplied as a non-setting putty. The pad is hand workable, re-useable and re-serviceable due to its non-setting properties.

Usage / Purpose

When electrical sockets and switches are installed in dry lining partitions, the original fire rating of the partition is compromised. Fitting Nullifire FO100 Putty Pads will reinstate the fire rating of the partition for up to two hours (depending on the partition fire rating and design). They will also prevent the passage of smoke and flames in a fire, as well as sound and air movement during service life, through the electrical socket, into the cavity.

Nullifire FO100 Putty Pads are shaped for use on both single and double electrical socket installations in dry lining walls. The pads are supplied in a cross shape for internal installation in a socket.

Necessary Tools

Suitable PPE only. No tools required.

Preparation

- Ensure that all surfaces are clean and free from dust and debris, and that the available pad is the correct size for the installation.
- Ensure power supply is isolated before commencing work.

Installation

- Remove the backing paper from one side of the pad
- Insert the pad into the socket back box so that the pad completely covers the back and sides.
- Make a slit to allow wiring to pass through the pad.
- Trim back around the box, working around the existing cable exit to ensure continuity.

Maintenance

No maintenance required after installation. Routine inspection recommended to ensure no damage.

Storage

Store between +5°C and +25°C in dry conditions. Keep away from sources of ignition.

Shelf Life

At least 12 months when stored as recommended.
